Explanation of Summary Handout Template

- Articles should be related to some type of Intervention, in the school or in the home.
- Any type of professional or scholarly publications (not just journals) are acceptable.
- The article must be recent (published after 2000).
- The entire summary must fit on 1 page. The boxes are to provide the writer with the approximate division of space, that is, summary should be the largest section of your summary.
- The summary heading (“Clear Solution Statement”) is the “solution” that your article addresses. An example is listed.
- These summaries are intended to be used as handouts given to others to read, e.g., teachers or parents at SST or IEP or parent conferences, etc. Thus, avoid professional jargons.
- When completing the summary, download it and type in the article information and email it directly to Brian Leung at bleung@lmu.edu.

Your summary will be reviewed by the Research Committee for inclusion in CASP Today. If your summary is published, you will earn “5 credits” toward a free workshop (15 credits needed) at the convention.

Any CASP member may submit a summary.
