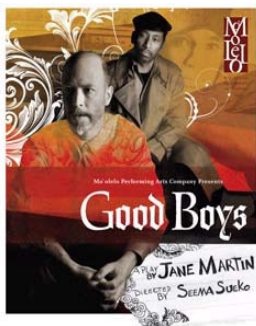

Richard Lieberman, NCSP, is coordinator of the Suicide Prevention Unit serving the 1 million students and staff of Los Angeles Unified School District. Mr. Lieberman is a leading presenter and author on suicide prevention, self-injury, and crisis, and he serves as a lecturer in the School of Education at Loyola Marymount University. On behalf of the US Department of Education and the National Organization of Victim's Assistance, Mr. Lieberman has been sent to school communities in the aftermath of tragedy and has participated on more than a dozen national crisis response teams. He is a founding member and current co-chair of the National Emergency Assistance Team, the response team of NASP and chairs NASP's Crisis Prevention and Intervention workgroup CASP's Crisis Specialty Group.

Douglas Siembieda is the Director of Special Education for Los Alamitos Unified School District. Mr. Siembieda is the current president of the California Association of School Psychologists (CASP), as well as a member of the California Crisis Specialty Group. Mr. Siembieda also serves on the faculty in the school psychology program at Loyola Marymount University.

Two fathers. A school shooting.

Eight years later, how do we forgive and heal?

Good Boys is the story of two men, one black one white, who meet eight years after a school shooting in which both their sons died, one a victim the other the shooter. As the fathers search for understanding and viciously cast blame, they confront difficult questions about vengeance and responsibility. *Is it possible to heal?*
